A CLOUDY START WITH A BRIGHT SPIRIT



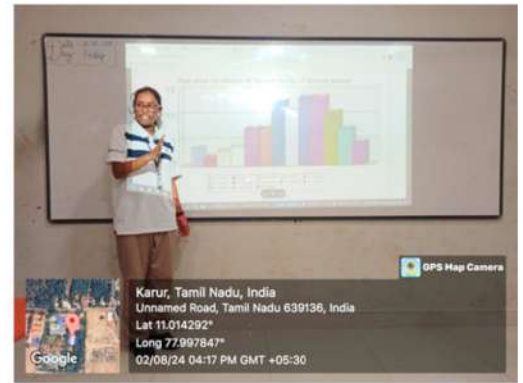

The war between Russia and Ukraine has evolved into one of the most dangerous conflicts in recent history. Russia's invasion has not only led to a brutal ground war but also sparked a major confrontation with NATO countries. The West has supplied Ukraine with advanced weapons and imposed heavy sanctions on Russia. The potential for a direct military clash between NATO forces and Russian troops remains a significant risk, with both sides engaging in aggressive posturing.

The Taiwan Strait has become a flashpoint for potential conflict between China and the United States.
