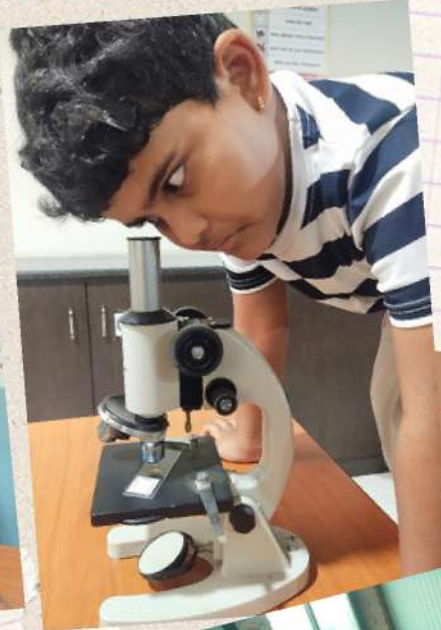
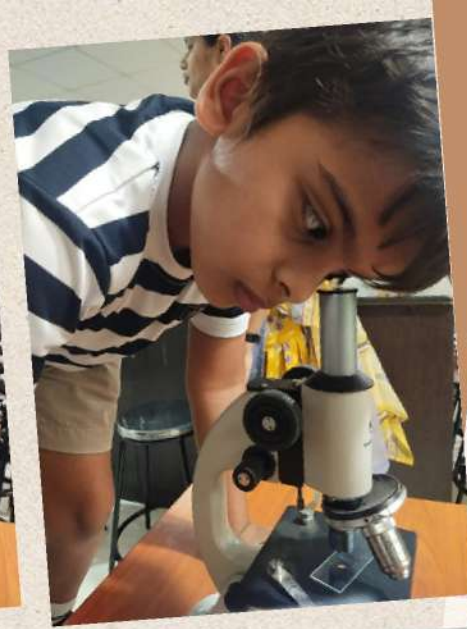
Activity : shape sorting activity
