AFTER A DECADE IN SINGAPORE, I MOVED TO MY MOTHERLAND, INDIA—A TRANSITION THAT BROUGHT NUMEROUS CHANGES AND CHALLENGES. ADAPTING TO NEW APPROACHES IN EDUCATION, CULTURAL PRACTICES, FAMILY DYNAMICS, AND SOCIAL ETIQUETTE, I FOUND MYSELF IMMERSED IN A COUNTRY RICH IN DIVERSITY, HERITAGE, FESTIVALS, AND FLAVORS. I WAS BOTH THRILLED AND A LITTLE OVERWHELMED!

EDUCATION AND LEARNING ONE OF THE BIGGEST ADJUSTMENTS WAS THE DIFFERENCE IN EDUCATIONAL SYSTEMS. IN SINGAPORE, I ATTENDED CHANGKAT CHANGI SECONDARY SCHOOL AND STUDIED GCE O-LEVEL EDUCATION THERE EMPHASIZES CRITICAL THINKING, PROBLEM-SOLVING, AND A WELL-ROUNDED EXPERIENCE. STUDENTS PREPARE INTENSELY FOR NATIONAL EXAMS FROM A YOUNG AGE, BALANCING ACADEMIC PRESSURE WITH SUPPORT SYSTEMS THAT PROMOTE MENTAL WELL-BEING. I ENJOYED PARTICIPATING IN MY SCHOOL'S AVIATION CLUB, WHERE I EXPLORED MY INTEREST IN AVIATION THROUGH ACTIVITIES LIKE MODEL-BUILDING AND FLIGHT SIMULATION.



IN INDIA, HOWEVER, EDUCATION IS HEAVILY FOCUSED ON ROTE LEARNING AND HIGH-STAKES EXAMS. HERE, I WAS SUDDENLY MORE WORRIED ABOUT MEMORIZING INFORMATION THAN SOLVING UNPREDICTABLE QUESTIONS. THE WEIGHT OF CARRYING MANY BOOKS INSTEAD OF JUST MY IPAD WAS A NEW CHALLENGE. INTERESTINGLY, I FOUND THAT STUDENTS HERE ARE MORE RELAXED ABOUT EXAMS AND SHOW STRONG SUPPORT FOR EACH OTHER, ESPECIALLY MY CLASSMATES IN 8A, WHO CREATE A WELCOMING AND ENCOURAGING ENVIRONMENT.

CULTURAL PRACTICES AND TRADITIONS CULTURAL PRACTICES ARE ESSENTIAL IN CONNECTING TO OUR ROOTS. WHILE I DIDN'T ENGAGE MUCH WITH TRADITIONAL PRACTICES IN SINGAPORE. INDIA EXPOSED ME TO VIBRANT CELEBRATIONS OF FESTIVALS I KNEW LITTLE ABOUT. IN SINGAPORE, ONLY DEEPAVALI WAS WIDELY RECOGNIZED IN SCHOOLS, WITH MINIMAL CELEBRATION. HOWEVER. EACH TIPS. FESTIVAL IS CELEBRATED ENTHUSIASTICALLY, CREATING A LIVELY, JOYFUL ATMOSPHERE. I PARTICULARLY ENJOYED VINAYAKA CHATURTHI. PERFORMANCES AND STORYTELLING INSPIRED ME TO LEARN MORE ABOUT MY CULTURAL HERITAGE.

CONCLUSION OVERALL, MY JOURNEY FROM SINGAPORE TO INDIA HAS BEEN ONE OF SIGNIFICANT CULTURAL SHOCK, MARKED BY BOTH CHALLENGES AND PERSONAL GROWTH. WHILE ADAPTING TOOK TIME, THE EXPERIENCE HAS ENRICHED MY PERSPECTIVE AND DEEPENED MY APPRECIATION FOR THE DIVERSITY AND WAYS OF LIFE IN INDIA.
